## This Weekend’s Gospel: Mark 4-26-34

Jesus said to the crowds: “This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how. Of its own accord the land yields fruit, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear. And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle at once, for the harvest has come.” He said, “To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade.” With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it. Without parables he did not speak to them, but to his own disciples he explained everything in private.

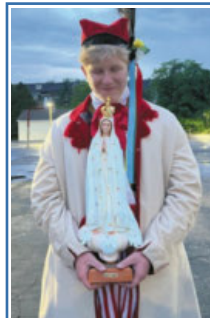


### Episode 124: Dryness in Prayer

The Fatima Mass and Procession** in May and June, with the Rosary prayed outside around the church on the 107th anniversary of Our Lady's apparitions in Fatima, is another event where parishioners and guests from both locations of our parish united in prayer. **Here we would especially like to thank Mr. Carmen Marchetti, who, sharing his carpentry talents with us, made a magnificent wooden base for the statue of Our Lady of Fatima, which was carried during the procession.** The heart rejoices and the mouth longs to praise the Lord at the sight of the gathered people praying together for the conversion of sinners, for peace in the world, for love in families, and for holy priestly vocations. We began the Fatima Procession on the 13th of May and will continue for the next few months through October, every 13th of the month. One of the other events attended by a large group of our parishioners, guests and youth was the **"Movie Night"**, where on Friday, May 31st, we screened the movie "The Shack". W kwietniu, **Watykańska Wystawa Cudów Eucharystycznych** zgromadziła liczne rodziny i parafian obu naszych lokacji. **Msza Święta i Procesja Fatimska** w maju i czerwcu z modlitwą różańcową na zewnątrz wokół kościoła, z okazji 107 rocznicy objawień Matki Bożej w Fatimie, to kolejne wydarzenie, podczas którego przy wspólnej modlitwie zjednoczyli się parafianie i goście z obu lokacji naszej parafii. **W tym miejscu chcielibyśmy szczególnie podziękować Panu Carmen Marchetti, który dzieląc się z nami swoim talentem stolarskim, wykonał wspaniałą drewnianą podstawę pod figurę Matki Bożej Fatimskiej, która była niesiona podczas procesji.** Serce się raduje i usta pragną chwalić Pana na widok zgromadzonych ludzi modlących się wspólnie o nawrócenie grzeszników, o pokój na świecie, o miłość w rodzinach i o święte powołania kapłańskie. Ostatnim wspólnym wydarzeniem tego roku, które miało miejsce 2 czerwca, w Niedzielę Bożego Ciała, była przepiękna dwujęzyczna **Procesja Bożego Ciała** do czterech ołtarzy wokół kościoła Świętego Tomasza Becketa, w której wzięła udział niezliczona liczba ludzi, w tym młodzież w strojach regionalnych z zespołu tanecznego "WICI", mali chłopcy z dzwoneczkami w ręku, którzy idąc przed Najświętszym Sakramentem dzwoniли dając znać wszystkim, że Jezus się zbliża oraz pierwszokomunijne dzieci w białych strojach sypiące kwiaty, które to układały się w kwiecistą ścieżkę po której w rękach kapłana przechodził sam Jezus w Najświętszym Sakramencie. Pomiędzy tymi wszystkimi wydarzeniami celebrowaliśmy wspólnie w naszej parafii Sakrament Bierzmowania i Sakrament Pierwszej Spowiedzi i Komunii Świętej. Radość wielka dla wszystkich dzieci i młodzieży, które otrzymały te sakramenty oraz dla ich rodziców i naszej wspólnoty parafialnej.

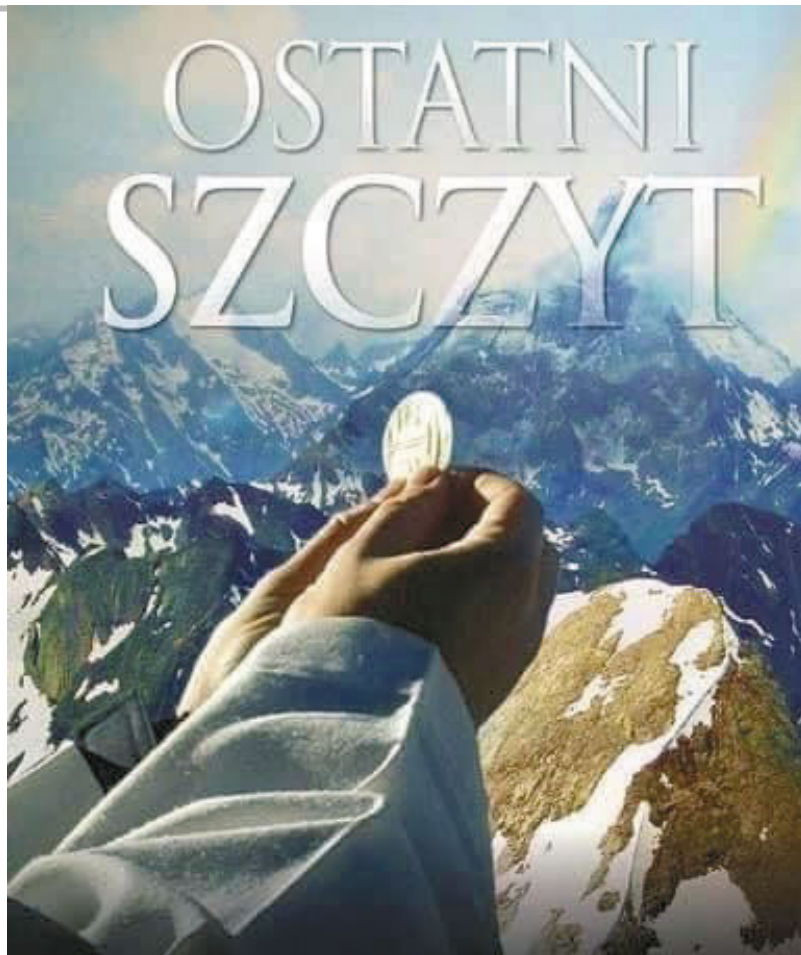

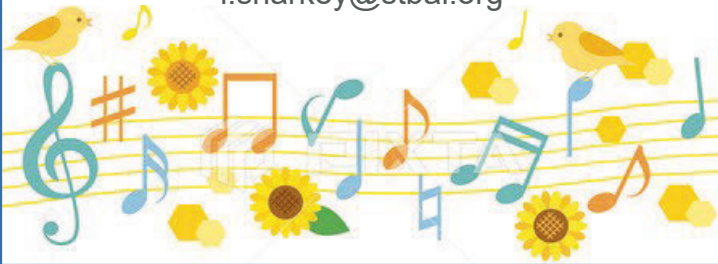


